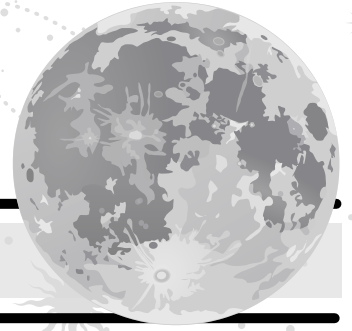


MOON ZOOM
