We also use it to communicate with parents, sharing whole school messages, class specific messages as well as being able to communicate with individual parents/ carers.

# *Golden Rules*

At Tornedale we have 3 key golden rules that we encourage in our children:

Be Safe

Be Ready

Be Respectful

When we see children demonstrating these behaviours, they are awarded a Dojo point.

Some of the weekly , half termly or termly Dojo points we reward are:



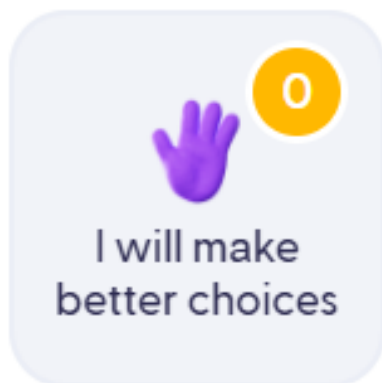
Read 3 times a week

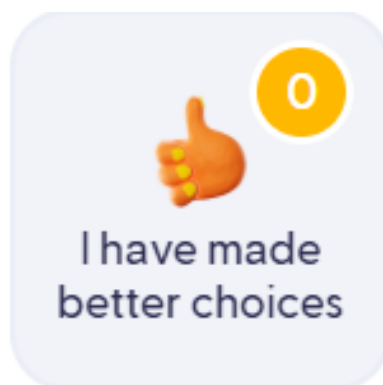
